Home-Bound/Bed-Bound Residents

This information will be important for emergency response teams to know in the event of flood, fire, or dam breach.

Register for Emergency Alerts

It is highly recommended that all residents register with SOUTH CENTRAL ALERT to receive emergency notifications from Dauphin County.

Emergency Evacuation

Dauphin/Middle Paxton Fire Company in combination with other county resources will assist in evacuating residents from Clarks Valley. In such an event it is requested that all residents report to the Dauphin Middle Paxton Fire Company (10 Elizabeth Ave.) to be accounted for and receive medical treatment if necessary. If you are not home in such an event, please call in to report the fact that you are safe (717-921-8242).

It is recommended that all residents keep an emergency "Go Bag" to be prepared for such an event. Go Bags should be kept at the ready and include at minimum 3-5 days of the following:

- Clothing
- Medications
- Identification
